

- 1) The RFP lists 15 total shelter/bench locations. Three of which are non-advertising structures. Does the City intend to convert these locations to advertising shelters?

Answer:

Main St. @ Industrial Park Dr will be the only one converted.

- 2) Does the City plan to expand/increase the total advertising shelter inventory? If so, what is the proposed plan and timeline for when this will occur?

Answer:

There are plans to add more advertising shelters. City plans to add one more advertising panels in 2019.

- 3) On June 18, 2018 the advertising shelter on the West side of Main St., South of Louise (in front of Walgreens) was destroyed by a vehicle. When does the City anticipate this shelter will be replaced?

Answer:

The City anticipates having the new shelter installed in spring 2019

- 4) In October of 2015 the City allowed the Eagle Scouts to install a community library box adjacent to the advertising shelter on the South side of E. North St (across from Doctor's Hospital). This permanent structure was installed in front of the West facing advertising panel making it no longer useable space for paid advertisements.

Would the City consider relocating this community library box to make this ad panel available again to generate revenue for the transit shelter advertising program?

Answer:

There are no plans to remove the community library box at this time.
