Bank Robbery Arrest

MANTECA, CA – On March 13, 2017 at approximately 6:00 PM, the Manteca Police Department received a report of a robbery in progress at Wells Fargo Bank located at 160 N. Main Street. Officers arrived on scene and established a perimeter on the bank. Approximately one minute later, the robbery suspect fled out of the south doors of the bank. The male suspect was chased by officers as he ran towards the 100 block of N. Grant Av. The suspect went into the backyard of a residence in the 100 Block of N. Lincoln Av. where he was taken into custody by officers. The suspect was in possession of the money he had stolen from the bank.

The suspect was identified as David Jeffrey Leech, 34 years old, from Manteca. Leech not armed and there were no injuries as a result of this incident. Officers located the Leech's vehicle, a gray Toyota Prius, unoccupied with the engine running in the alley near the bank. Leech was charged with robbery and resisting arrest. He was booked at San Joaquin County Jail.
