Two Arrested for Mail Theft, Fraud and Drug Charges

Manteca, CA – On June 16, 2016, a fraud report was filed online with the Manteca Police Department. The victim reported their credit card stolen from their mailbox and fraudulently used several times in Manteca as well as Tracy, Dutch Flat, Citrus Heights and Nevada. Through an in-depth investigation by Community Service Officer Lewis, Officer Walmer and Detective Montoya, suspect Devina Olsen was identified as using the victim's credit card for fraudulent purchases in Manteca.

On Tuesday, August 23, 2016, Manteca Police Investigations and Street Crime Unit (SCU) Detectives served a search warrant at the suspect's residence in the 400 block of Martha Street in Manteca. During the search they recovered stolen mail from well over 100 victims. The mail included credit cards, bank statements, government forms, W-2 forms, California Driver's Licenses, etc. They also located two homemade mail box keys. Detectives checked the keys and they unlocked the cluster mail boxes. Also located was approximately one ounce of methamphetamine and property purchased fraudulently with stolen credit cards.

Olsen and her boyfriend, Guy Zielske, were arrested and booked into the San Joaquin County Jail. The US Postal Inspectors were contacted and assisting with this case.

Devina Marie Olsen, 33-year-old Manteca Resident

Charges: Possession of ID/ 10 or more persons, possession of stolen property (10 counts), possession of a controlled substance for sale, possession of burglary tools and forgery.

Guy Zachary Zielske, 28-year old Manteca Resident

Charges: Possession of ID/ 10 or more persons, possession of stolen property (10 counts), possession of a controlled substance for sale, possession of burglary tools, felon in possession of ammo and felony committed while out on bail.

Zielske also had an outstanding felony warrant for evading a Police Officer out of Alameda County.
