



# PUBLIC WORKSHOP #3 NOTICE

WHAT: The City of Manteca has continued to work on the Reclaimed Water Facilities Master Plan and has evaluated multiple alternatives for recycled water use. The purpose of the Master Plan is to evaluate the role that recycled water can play in creating a drought-proof water supply for the City and the wider region, and in diversifying the City's water supply portfolio.

Engineering staff would like to invite the public to their third and final workshop to discuss decisions made since the last workshop. The workshop will discuss the cost and benefits of various local and regional alternatives for the City's recycled water that will be included in the Master Plan. The workshop will also discuss the recommended plan for the City's recycled water use.

The presentation will be followed by a question/answer period to provide an opportunity for public comment prior to finalization of the plan and presentation to City Council.
