



PUBLIC WORKSHOP NOTICE

WHAT: The City of Manteca has recently begun work on a Reclaimed Water Facilities Master Plan. The purpose of the Master Plan is to evaluate the role that recycled water can play in creating a drought-proof water supply for the City and the wider region, and in diversifying the City's water supply portfolio.

Engineering staff would like to invite the public to a workshop to explain the potential uses of recycled water that will be included in the Master Plan, and to share the experience of other cities using recycled water for landscape irrigation, agricultural irrigation, groundwater recharge, and other uses.

The public meeting will include informational material on recycled water, potential non-potable recycled water uses by the City of Manteca, and potential groundwater recharge uses. The presentation will be followed by a question/answer period to provide an opportunity for public comment prior to the development of alternatives for further analysis.
