



PUBLIC WORKSHOP #2 NOTICE

WHAT: The City of Manteca has been working on the Reclaimed Water Facilities Master Plan and has made significant progress. The purpose of the Master Plan is to evaluate the role that recycled water can play in creating a drought-proof water supply for the City and the wider region, and in diversifying the City's water supply portfolio.

Engineering staff would like to invite the public to their second workshop to discuss progress made since the last workshop. The workshop will discuss the local and regional alternatives uses for the City's recycled water that will be included in the Master Plan.

The public meeting will include informational material on recycled water, and the alternatives identified for non-potable recycled water use by the City of Manteca. The presentation will be followed by a question/answer period to provide an opportunity for public comment prior to the development of alternatives for further analysis.
